DEFINITION: GAMBLING

- to play a game in which you can win or lose money or possessions or other valuable things
- to risk losing (an amount of money) in a game or bet
- to risk losing (something valuable or important) in order to do or achieve something
- to play a game for money or property: to bet on an uncertain outcome
- to take a chance

DEFINITION: BETTING

- to risk losing something (such as money) if your guess about what will happen is wrong
- to make decisions that are based on the belief that something will happen or is true

DEFINITION: WHAT IS MISSING

- An act by which one party consciously risks money or other stakes
- Hoping that he/she will make a gain
- Done at the expense of another person
- Nothing of value is given in return to the person from whom one has gained

TYPES OF GAMBLING

- Horse Racing: Odds stuck against you
- Casino Games: The house always wins
- Raffle Tickets: For a good cause; one wins, many lose
- Lottery: Promises big wins on advertisements
- Betting: Placing and hoping
- Free Gifts: Supermarkets, petrol stations, etc.
- Bingo Jackpot: You are the next winner
- Ponzi Schemes/Pyramid Schemes

- 1. Gambling is wrong; but what is wrong with Betting?
- 2. What if Gambling is more thinking and calculation than chance? What if I have been winning my bets?
- 3. What if it's budgeted for and there is no addiction?

- 5. What about Insurance? Financial Investments?
- 6. Is it wrong if the parties have agreed to the outcome?
- 7. Does Casting the Lot equal Gambling?

BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES

- 1. Gambling is NOT explicitly mentioned in the Bible: BUT is it Beneficial? 1 Corinthians 6:12
- 2. Stewardship: Of resources given by God. Luke 18, 1 Corinthians 4:2. Glorifying God with it? 1 Corinthians 10:31, Matthew 6:19-21, :24.
- 3. It hurts others: Matthew 22:39, 1 Corinthians 10:24
- 4. It preys on the weak Romans 14:21, Rom 15:1-2
- 5. Work ethic: Genesis 2:15 ... Little by little make it grow, Proverbs 13:11

BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES

- 6. Addiction. We should not be mastered by anything: 1 Corinthians 6:12, 2 Peter 2:19
- 7. Motivation: Greed Gen 3:1-6, Luke 12:15; Discontentment 1 Ti 6:9-10; Depression
- 8. Faith: OR Chance? Romans 14:23
- 9. Culture: Associated with Criminal activity. Casinos and Clubs? Makes others stumble. 1 Cor 8:9-13
- 10. What Would Jesus Do?

THE IMPACT OF GAMBLING

POSITIVE (Very Few)

- 1. Charities ... KCS
- 2. Governments taxation and service 3. Raffles raise for a need

THE IMPACT OF GAMBLING

- NEGATIVE (Far Outweigh the good!)
- 1. Irresponsibility
 - Broken marriages
 - Broken families
- 2. Depression
 - Sicknesses and hospitalizations

- Increase in suicides
- 3. Addictions
 - Sensuality
 - Drugs

CONCLUSION

- Are all forms of gambling and levels sinful? Probably not.
 - Life is full of risky choices; Be careful.
- Gambling is NOT a good choice. It contributes to the sufferings of others
